#### **Evaluation Overview**

- Fall 2018: Fidelity of Implementation Interviews
- Feb March 2019: Site visits at 4 institutions
- March 2019: Focus groups with faculty
- June 2019: Student Success

### **Student Focus Groups**

- 4 Student Focus Groups
- 45 Students Interviewed
- 247 Survey Responses
- Representative of transition courses in math and English as well as coreq courses in math and English

### **Student Feedback**

### **Findings**

"I like that the size of my class is small, and I also like that I feel I'm getting extra pointers on how to be successful in 111."

"I think this course is practical, if review is being done for the main course. Otherwise this course is not helpful if I'm currently trying to learn new stuff in MAT 171 and being taught math that isn't applied to the course."






# Implementing RISE in the midst of declining/stagnant enrollments










### **Math Gateway Courses Success**








