SUSTAINING MOMENTUM TO SUPPORT ADULT LEARNERS IN NORTH CAROLINA

Since 2021, the John M. Belk Endowment has supported 20 colleges as they work to recruit and retain adult learners on their campuses. It's important to note, however, that colleges do not need to be involved in NC Reconnect to support adult learners. We hope this session sparks ideas of how to both start and continue work related to adult learner success.
